

# REPLAY @ THE SOUTHBANK CENTRE INSTALLATION MAINTENANCE ROLE

## THE ROLE

The Herd are looking for individuals with experience in making and fabricating to work on a part time freelance basis maintaining our play exhibition, REPLAY, at The Southbank Centre. REPLAY is an installation and experience for children aged 0-11 years and their families, made entirely out of reclaimed and recycled materials. Part adventure playground, part installation, REPLAY encourages children and grown ups to play side by side - building, making, imagining, dressing up, creating, designing, inventing and much more. REPLAY advocates the benefits of play and explores a sustainable approach to play.

REPLAY runs at the Southbank Centre from 22nd January - 6th June 2025.

The Installation Maintenance Role will visit the site 3 or 4 times a week on selected weeks, checking that all elements of the installation are in order and making any necessary repairs where possible.

We are looking for resourceful individuals with creative, positive, open outlooks who have an interest in sustainable practice. We're interested in talking to people with experience in general making and/or people with specific skills in working with a range of materials. You might have your own artistic practice, experience or training in theatre design, prop making, sculpture, textiles, carpentry, painting, or something completely different!
